10. Event Details:

GSFC University, GUIITAR Council, Students Startup Innovation Policy (SSIP 2.0), Startup Gujarat Cell, and Institution's Innovation Council organized an Event to celebrate World Entrepreneurs Day on 21st August, 2023, at the Auditorium, SoT, GSFCU.

Ms. Divena Sharma from BSc. Biotechnology and Ms. Vidhi Mandaviya from BTech CSE moderated the session.

Dr. Saroj Shekhawat, CEO of the GUIITAR Council, welcomed the invited speaker, Dr. Jitendra Wagh, and felicitated him with a plant. She said entrepreneurs stand as the driving force behind innovation, crafting new solutions, technologies, and pathways that reshape industries and societies. Their endeavors not only generate economic growth but also ignite a chain reaction of job creation, driving communities towards prosperity.

Dr. Jitendra Wagh shared his journey in research and his pursuit of a Ph.D. in molecular biology. He shared his first job experience after completing his Ph.D. as a research scientist, where he worked on projects related to fermentation and the development of new products. He mentioned challenges with marketing and competition in the industry, along with his work on developing animal-free proteins and targeting specific proteins for



synthesis. He highlighted the importance of patience, dedication, and quality in biotech entrepreneurship, as well as collaborations with government institutions and national and international companies. He emphasized the social impact and health benefits of his products. Additionally, he discussed challenges faced during the creation of an animal-free product, including financial considerations and potential market barriers.
