GSFC University and GUITAR Council have organized a webinar on “Orientation of SSIP 2.0” on 13th January, 2022 from 11:30 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. through virtual platform Google meet in association with Gujarat Knowledge Society and SSIP Cell, Govt. of Gujarat.

Shri Hiranmay Mahanta, CEO, i-Hub, Govt. of Gujarat has introduced invited guest Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, Principal Secretary Education Department, Govt. of Gujarat to the participants.

The session begins with an inaugural the virtual message by Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, Principal Secretary Education Department, Govt. of Gujarat. He launched SSIP 2.0 Policy and informed achievement of the first phase of SSIP 1.0 (2017 to 2021) to the participants. The first phase covered 6276 student innovation, 1122 IP filing, 2132 student startups and provided grant-in-aid to 186 Universities/Institutes.

Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, PS, Education Dept., GoG said that the SSIP 2.0 policy emphasizes horizontal inclusion of all schemes across the academia and vertical extension in Schools, Institutes and Universities. SSIP 2.0 has provisions of Rs. 500 crores for the policy period in which Rs. 200 crores shall be mobilized via existing resources such as the internal budget of University/Institutes, Private & CSR funds and others.

Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, PS, Education Dept., GoG said that the SSIP 2.0 launched with a vision of sustainable development and inclusive growth towards the realization of

Aatmanirbhar Gujarat. It aims to introduce many innovative approaches like digitization and paperless process, good governance for timely and adequate support to beneficiaries. Special incentives to sunrise sectors and innovation can add further our inclusive growth of the state.

Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, PS, Education Dept., GoG shared goals & objectives of SSIP 2.0 as under:

- Outreach and sensitize 5 million students for innovation and entrepreneurship, covering at least 1000 Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) and 10,000 Schools of the State
- Support to 10,000 student-led Proof-of-Concepts (PoCs/Prototype)
- Assistance to 5000 IP filings
- Build capacity for at least 500 educational institutions and universities in the State, to have a robust preincubation support system for beneficiaries
- Nurture 1000 school student led innovations
- Groom 1500 student Start-ups and upscale existing Start-ups
- Incubate 500 Start-up (physical and virtual)
- Support to 500 Start-up under Start-up Srujan Seed Support (Up to INR 10 Lac)

Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, PS, Education Dept., GoG informed that any person up to the age of 35 years, who is, school students/diploma/vocational/undergraduate/postgraduate/doctorate students or alumna/alumnus or dropout from school/institute/university is eligible to received SSIP 2.0 grant. At the last, he suggested to sensitize, orient and disseminating SSIP 2.0 information to the beneficiary.

Shri G. T. Pandya, Director, Technical Education, Govt. of Gujarat expressed vote of thanks to Shri S. J. Haider, IAS, Principal Secretary, Education Department, GoG, Shri M. Nagarajan, IAS, Director, Higher Education, Govt. of Gujarat, Gujarat Knowledge Society, SSIP and iHub team for the launching of SSIP 2.0.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar, Sr. Manager, GUITAR Council has welcomed GSFC University Management, CEO-GUITAR Council, Dean, Associate Deans, Faculty and Students.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar shared the journey of GSFC University under SSIP 1.0. GSFC University has signed MoU on 20th January, 2021 with Gujarat Knowledge Society, a nodal agency of Education Department, GoG for SSIP implementation. Rs. 3.75 lakhs

grant received by GSFC University on 2nd February, 2021 for the Start-up Ecosystem development.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar informed that GSFC University has Technical Committee, University Level Startup Committee and IPR Scrutiny Committee for various approvals under SSIP. A total of Rs. 9.67 lakhs utilized by 13 student's teams for PoC/Prototype Development out of 16 approved projects and 1 Patent filed.

A total Rs. 15.00+ lakhs utilized under SSIP where 50% support will be given by SSIP and 50% contributed by GSFC University. GSFC University has also contributed Rs. 6.00+ lakhs extra (100%) for the Incubation Centre development.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar informed that GSFC University has 5000+ sq. ft. dedicated infrastructure allotted for the Maker Lab, Co-working space, Event room, Tod-Fod-Jod Lab, Mentoring Room etc. In last year 12+ events were organized by sensitizing 1000+ students towards innovation, entrepreneurship and IPR.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar invited Dhairya Sharma and Manshi Chaudhari to share their startup/PoC/IP filing journey with the students.

Dhairya Sharma, 7th Sem, Mechanical Engg, SoT, GSFC University has shared his experience with GSFC University and GUITAR Council for developing his innovation Hydro-AIDE (Automation System for Hydroponics). His team has received Rs. 1.42 lakhs support to develop Prototype under SSIP 1.0 and co-working space at the GSFC University Incubation Centre.

Manshi Chaudhari, 7th Sem, Chemical Engg., SoT, GSFC University has explained how the IPR Centre of GSFC University has helped her to protect innovation by filing a Patent. Her team received Rs. 25,000/- support for Patent filing under SSIP 1.0

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar congratulates the Education Department, Govt. of Gujarat for launching SSIP 2.0 policy.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar played a short video film on SSIP 2.0 prepared by SSIP Cell, Govt. of Gujarat. The period of the Policy will be from January 11, 2022 to March 31, 2027. He shared the presentation prepared by SSIP Cell, Govt. Gujarat on SSIP 2.0.

Mr. Kirankumar Parmar shared Vision, Mission, Comparison between SSIP 1.0 and SSIP 2.0, Goals & Objectives, Strategy to implement, Eligibility of University, Eligibility of Institute, Eligibility of Beneficiary, Interventions, Financial support, IPR Support

and others in details of SSIP 2.0 with students. He said beneficiaries will receive PoC/Prototype development support up to Rs. 10 lakhs and Patent filing support up to Rs. 75,000/- for domestic and Rs. 1.5 lakh for other countries. School student (class 9 to class 12) will receive support up to Rs. 20,000/- per PoC/Prototype.

Dr. Nikhil Zaveri, Provost, GSFC University congratulate Govt. of Gujarat for launching student and startup friendly policy SSIP 2.0. He invites students to take benefits of PoC/Prototype Development and IPR filing grant under the policy. It's a good opportunity for students to work on their idea while studying and converting into startups.

Dr. Nikhil Zaveri shared GSFC University Roadmap for the next five years to implement SSIP 2.0 with students as under:

- Incubation centre space will be an increase from 5000+ to 10000+ sq. ft.
- Outreach and sensitize 5000+ students
- Support to 150+ students led Innovative Ideas
- Support to 100+ students led Proof of Concept/Prototype
- Assistance to 70+ IP filing
- Support to 20+ students startups
- Rs. 150+ lakhs support to students innovators
- Faculty/Industry mentorship programme: One to One Mentoring, Group Mentoring and Virtual mentoring
- Will set up all the necessary infrastructure for startups and will develop Idea Village to provide a place out of the classroom for information interaction on idea development
- Will organize capacity building programme for faculty, students and startups
- Pedagogical Changes: Case study based learning, problem based learning, experiential learning
- Partnership with Experts, Industry, Industry Association, Angel Investor, Venture Capitalist, IPR Experts etc.

Dr. Nikhil Zaveri urged students to work on people's problems and convert a new idea into startup that can be commercialized.

Dr. Saroj Shekhawat, CEO, GUITAR Council expressed the vote of thanks to the Shri P. K. Taneja, IAS (Retd.), President - GSFCU, Dr. Nikhil Zaveri, Provost - GSFCU, Shri R. B. Panchal, Registrar & Director Admn. - GSFCU, GUITAR Council Team Members, Teaching staff and Non-teaching staff for their continuous support to implement SSIP 1.0 at the GSFC University. She also congratulated students whose innovative projects/IPR approved by the committee under SSIP 1.0

In the end, Dr. Saroj Shekhawat invites all the students to apply for PoC/Prototype/IPR support under SSIP 2.0.

Orientation of SSIP 2.0 increases the awareness amongst students/faculty towards PoC/Prototype development, IPR, Innovation, Startups and other benefits available for them. Students/faculty understands the process of availing the benefits under SSIP 2.0

Participants also know the progress of the last one year under SSIP 1.0 and planning of next five years of SSIP 2.0

11. How will it be useful for Students/School/University:

Students may apply under SSIP 2.0 for the PoC/Prototype Development, IPR Support, Maker Lab access, Incubation support and other benefits. Education Department, GoG will provide 50% Grant and GSFC University will provide 50% Grant under SSIP 2.0.

GSFC University will implement SSIP 2.0 for the financial year 2022 – 2027 with the support of the Education Department, Govt. of Gujarat.
