

## Annexure-1

### **Role and Responsibilities of University Level Startup Committee (ULSC):**

- 1) The Committee shall act as a think-tank assigned for strengthening the Startup ecosystem in GSFC University.
- 2) The Committee will plan out activities of GUIITAR Council and GSFC University well in advance in order to carry out such activity with effectiveness.
- 3) The Committee will supervise all the activities of GUIITAR Council under Nodal Institute mandate.
- 4) The Committee will supervise all the activities under the SSIP 2.0 mandate.
- 5) The Committee will analyse and update the Startup Policy periodically.
- 6) The Committee may include domain experts as members whenever need arises.
- 7) Any decision in committee will be taken in Quorum, wherein 50% member's attendance is essential apart from student members.
