- 10. Major discussions in the event:

The two-day Faculty Entrepreneurship Program (FEP), held on July 1st and 2nd, 2025, at GSFC University. A total of 21 faculty members participated. The program was conducted in collaboration with TIDES, IIT-Roorkee. Here are the major discussion and learning points from each session expert-wise:

Day 1: Tuesday, 1st July 2025

Speaker: Dr. Azam Ali Khan – CEO, TIDES, IIT Roorkee

Session: Aim, Objectives & Best Practices at TIDES + Faculty Entrepreneurship Policy

- Importance of moving academic research from lab to market.
- Faculty can legally start companies as *non-executive directors* while in service.
- Ownership should be balanced—too much equity held by faculty hinders investment.
- Team-building and involving professionals in startups is key to success.











- Incorporation of startups should preferably be under *Private Limited* for funding.
- Faculty-led startup examples from IITs (e.g., Agnikul, Hyperloop, Indie Energy).
- Introduction to faculty startup policy at IIT Roorkee and compliance structures.

Speaker: Prof. Rhythym Singh – Co-Founder, Urja Analytics

Session: Journey of a Faculty Entrepreneur

- Transitioned from academic research to entrepreneurship.
- Emphasized "Academia 3.0" teaching becoming tertiary to research and entrepreneurship.
- Real-world impact of research is essential for societal benefit.
- Shared personal journey in renewable energy and product-based research.
- Highlighted challenges like policy alignment, industry integration, and funding.
- Importance of interdisciplinary collaboration and real-industry exposure for students.

Speaker: Shri Abhinav Kanagat – Founder, August Educare

Session: Product Development Strategies

- Focused on transforming research ideas into scalable products.
- Discussed generic strategies for MVP (Minimum Viable Product) creation.
- Encouraged non-sector-specific thinking to ensure broader applicability.
- Importance of user feedback, iterations, and clear problem-solution fit
- Value of continuous innovation and validation in early-stage development.











Day 2: Wednesday, 2nd July 2025

Speaker: Shri K.K. Singh – Managing Partner, KKSA & Associates

Session: Legal, Compliance & Banking Support for Faculty Ventures

- Legal structures for startups (OPC, LLP, Pvt. Ltd.), with preference for Pvt. Ltd.
- Importance of regulatory compliance for startups.
- Bank account setup, PAN, GST registration processes.
- Roles and responsibilities of non-executive directors.
- Taxation and Director loans—how faculty can financially support their ventures.

Speaker: Shri Amit Singh Moga – Co-Founder, The Doctorpreneur Academy

Session: Product Commercialization - Sales & Marketing Strategies

- Emphasized importance of go-to-market strategy for product success.
- Sales strategies based on startup lifecycle stages.
- Target audience identification and customer segmentation.
- Using storytelling and digital platforms for marketing.
- Pricing models, partnerships, and pilot projects as entry strategies.

Speaker: Dr. Azam Ali Khan - CEO, TIDES, IIT Roorkee

Session: Business Model Canvas (BMC) & Hands-on Practice

- Participants divided into groups to develop BMCs for chosen ideas.
- Practical session focused on:
 - Value proposition
 - Customer segments
 - Key partners
 - Revenue streams
 - Cost structure
- Reinforced collaborative thinking and lean startup approach.
- Feedback was provided to each group to improve their business model logic.






